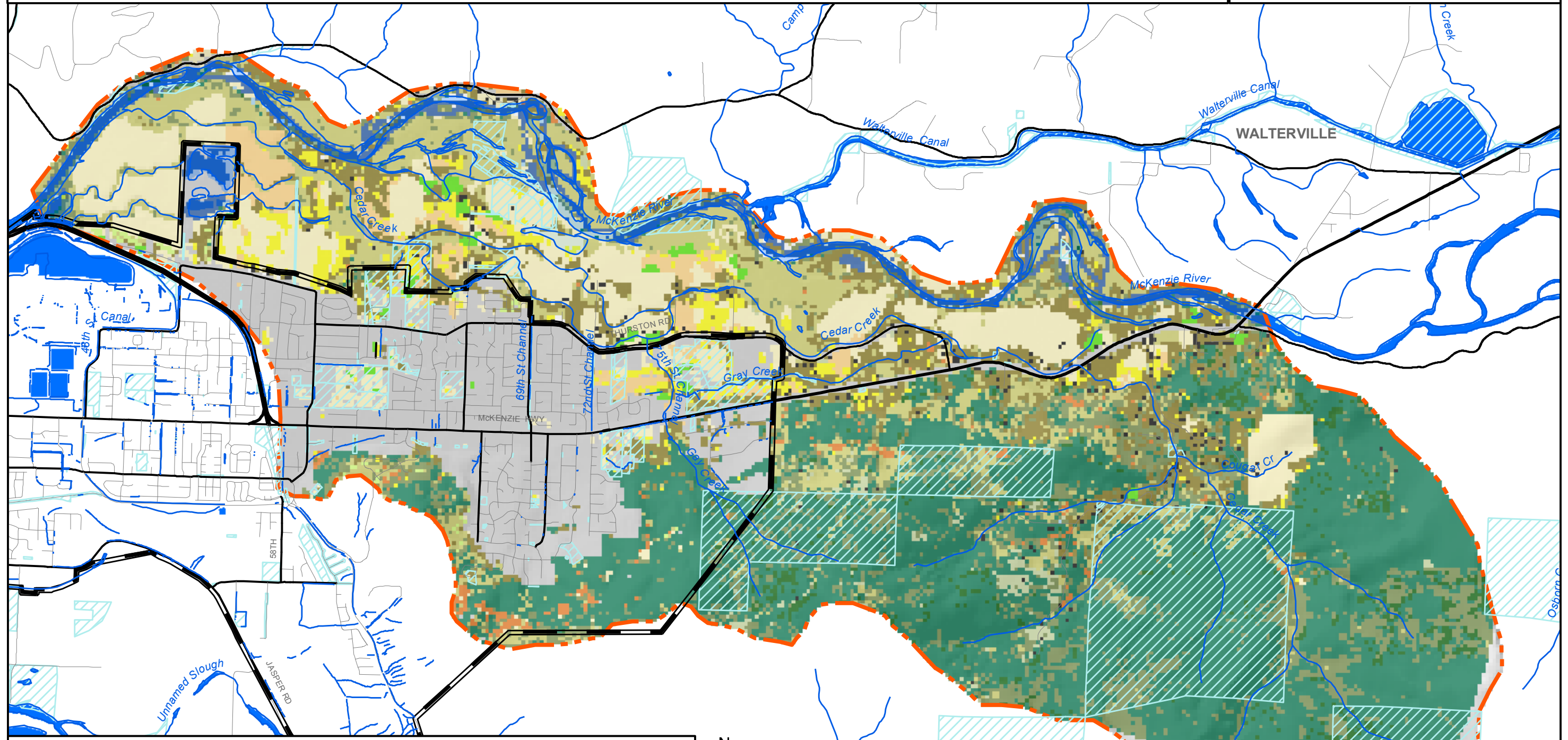
- Closed & semi-closed mixed conifer forest or woodlot < 200 years
